

## IDENTIFICATION OF REPEATED INFRINGEMENTS UNDER THE REGIONAL OBSERVER PROGRAMME

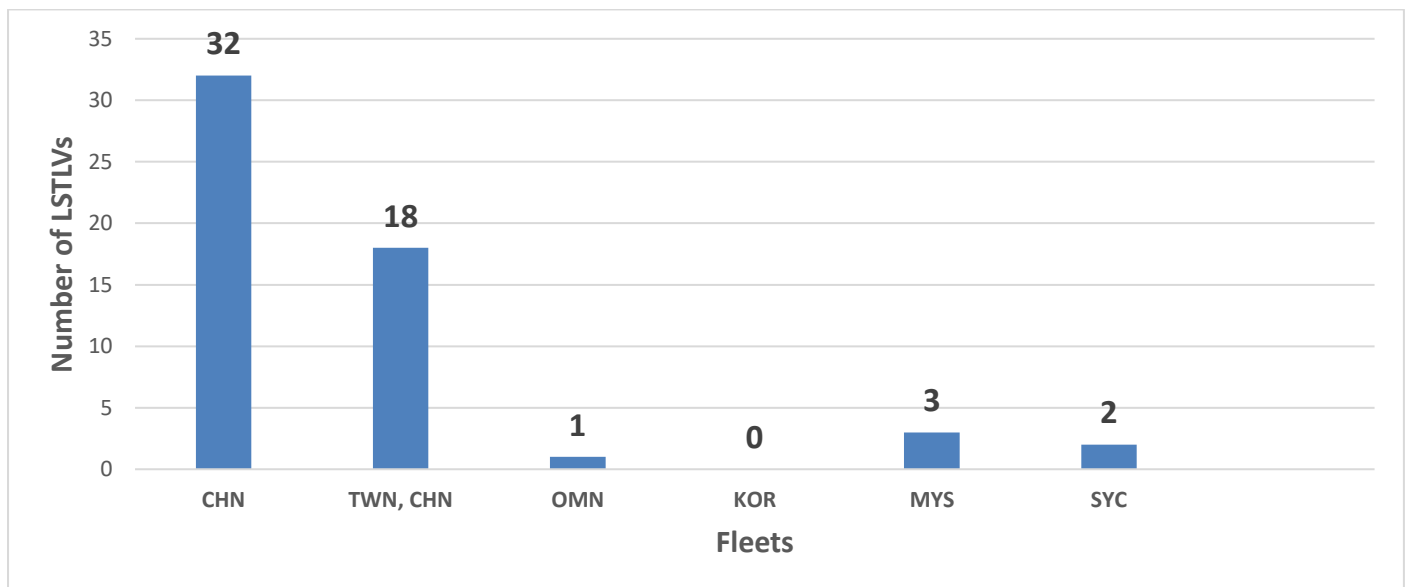
In line with 1) the requirement of IOTC Resolution 18/06 *On establishing a programme for transhipment by large-scale fishing vessels*, and 2) the recommendation made by the Compliance Committee at its 10<sup>th</sup> Session:

53. The CoC **RECOMMENDED** that the Secretariat follow, from one year to the next, the potential infringement cases identified so as to allow the CoC to identify repeated cases of infringement.

This document provides a summary of repeated cases of potential infringements of IOTC Resolutions by large-scale tuna longline vessels (LSTLVs) and carrier vessels, as recorded by observers deployed under the at-sea Transhipment Programme during 2018.

### Identification of possible repeated infringements by LSTLVs in 2018.

From the seven fleets (7) which have transhipped in 2018, six (6) fleets have vessels with one or more records of repeated possible infringements in 2018. In all, a total of 56 cases of repeated possible infringements were recorded in 2018. The number of LSTLVs with repeated possible infringements in 2018 are presented by fleet in Figure 1.



**Figure 1: Number of LSTLVs, by fleet, with repeated possible infringements in 2018.**

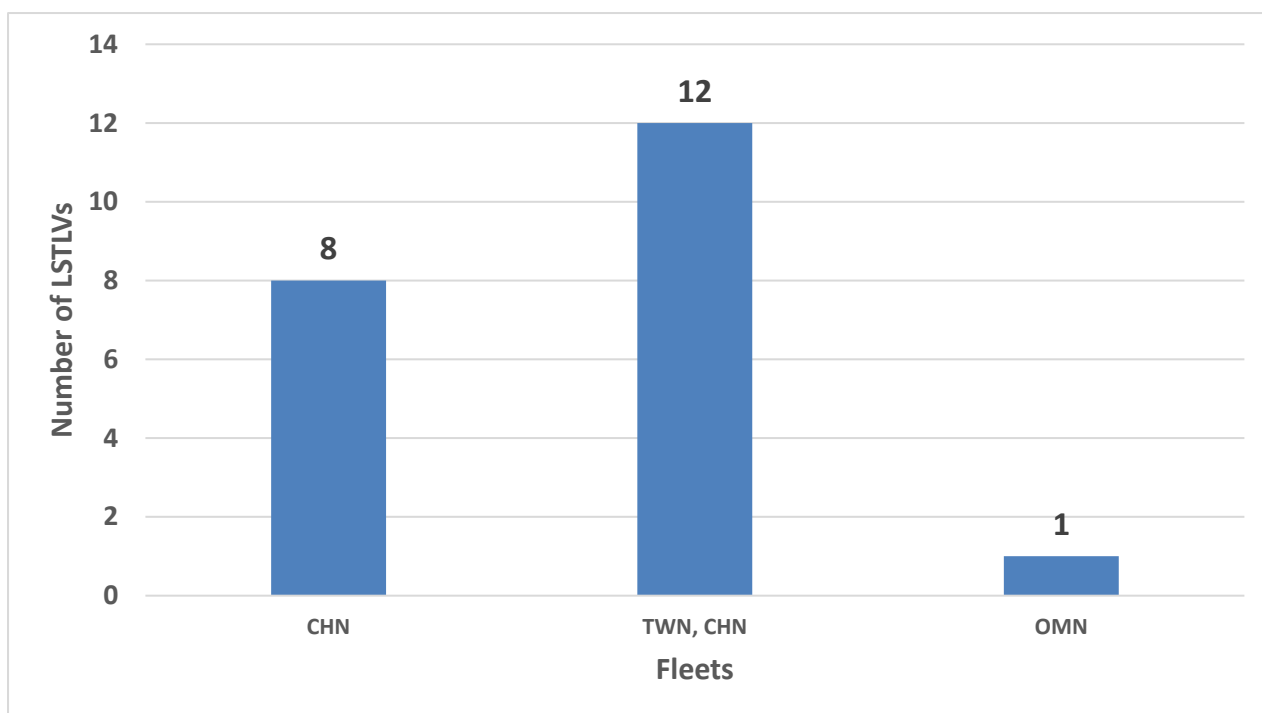
**Identification of repeated possible infringements by LSTLVs in 2018 that have a record of possible infringement in 2017.**

Three fleets have LSTLVs with a record of repeated possible infringements in 2018 that have one or more records of possible infringements in 2017:

- Thirty two (32) LSTLVs of the fleet of China have been identified as repeated possible offender in 2018. Twelve (12) of those 32 vessels have a record of possible infractions in 2017.
- Eighteen (18) LSTLVs of the fleet of Taiwan, Province of China, have been identified as repeated possible offender in 2018. Eight (8) of those 18 vessels have a record of possible infractions in 2017.
- One (1) LSTLV of the fleet of Oman has been identified as repeated possible offender in 2018. This LSTLV has a record of possible infractions in 2017.

The number of LSTLVs with repeated possible infringements in 2018 and with a record of possible infringements in 2017 are presented by fleet in Figure 2, below.



**Figure 2: Number of LSTLVs by fleet with repeated possible infringements in 2018 and with a record of possible infringements in 2017.**

Three fleets have LSTLVs with a record of repeated possible infringements in 2018; with no record of possible infringement in 2017:

- One (1) LSTLV of the fleet of Japan has been identified with repeated possible offender in 2018.
- Two (2) LSTLVs of the fleet of Seychelles have been identified with repeated possible offender in 2018.

- Three (3) LSTLVs of the fleet of Malaysia have been identified with repeated possible offender in 2018.

The list of the LSTLVs with repeated potential infringements in 2018 and record of potential infringements in 2017 are summarized by category of possible infractions, and by fleet, in the Appendix I.

#### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

That the CoC16:

- 1) **NOTE** paper IOTC–2019–CoC16–08 Add\_1, which describe and identify possible repeated infringements under the at-sea transshipments programme in 2018,
- 2) **NOTE** that three fleets, China, Taiwan Province of China and Oman, have occurrence of possible repeated infringements in 2018 and have a record of possible infringement in 2017.
